

15 CRAIGSIDE LIBRARY SERVICES

The 15 CRAIGSIDE LIBRARY strives to build, maintain, and make accessible a collection of fiction and nonfiction books, DVDs, and other related materials for all residents.

The library is basically “self-service,” with assistance provided by library volunteers. Fiction books, DVDs and paperbacks are located on the ground floor. Non-fiction and large print books are located in the basement.

COMPUTERIZED LIBRARY CATALOG If you wish to find out if a book, favorite author or movie is in our 15 C collection, you may ask a library volunteer for assistance OR use the instruction sheet, “15 Craigside Automated Library Catalog” placed on the bookshelf near the library’s Macintosh computers.

BOOK AND DVD PURCHASES Requests for the library to PURCHASE a book or DVD may be submitted on a 15 C Library Book & DVD Request Slip. Request slips are located in the ground floor library. Prior to purchase, all requests are carefully considered by members of the 15 C Library Committee.

LIBRARY BULLETIN BOARD To find out what’s happening in our library, check the bulletin board on the ground floor for updates and announcements.

“FREE BOOKS: HELP YOURSELF” Residents may help themselves any book or DVD in the basket located near the door to the clinic in the basement.

HEALTH CARE CENTER (Second Floor) A modest collection of books and magazines is maintained on the second floor.
