## JOAN FEDDERN: ROOSTERS

Joan Feddern collected figures of roosters for about ten years before she and Ed moved to Sagewood seven years ago. The collection began when Ed's mother gave them a pair of polychrome pottery roosters and later an all-white one. The collection seemed to grow on its own, with others that struck Joan's whimsy added without plan. Eventually there were sixteen of them, made of a variety of materials, including ceramic, metal, and wood. Most are ornamental, but there are also tea pots in the form of roosters. Joan had no place to show them as a collection before moving to Sagewood, where they now enliven the tops of the cabinets in their kitchen.
